Mr. Clark, as you are aware, this office serves as City Attorney for the City. In that capacity we have been directed to respond to your earlier email to the City Clerk.

You originally requested : *Documentation of the city business activities carried out by Don Schweitzer, Brett Murdock and Tim O'Donnell during their trip to Anseong, South Korea and Hanno, Japan from September 28 through October 9, 2012.*

You were advised by the City Clerk that the City has no records responsive to your request. Should there be no such records, you then requested "a full and complete accounting of the city related activities." As you are probably aware, the California Public Records Act (CPRA) exists to provide the public with access to records of the public's business. That occurs through a process designed to make available for review, identifiable, non-exempt "public records", as defined in Gov. Code Section 6252(e). Your request reasonably described specific records you wished provided, and you were advised by the City Clerk that the City has no such records. With that response, the City Clerk completed her legal obligation under the CPRA.

Boiled down, your request for a "complete accounting" is a request for information which, as you are now aware, is not reflected in public records in the City's possession. Neither the CPRA nor any other provision of State law requires the City to provide you with any further response.
