A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BREA, CALIFORNIA, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, DESIGNATING THE CITY OF LAGOS de MORENO, JALISCO, UNITED STATES OF MEXICO, AS A SISTER CITY OF THE CITY OF BREA.

WHEREAS, it is to the mutual advantage of the cities of Brea, State of California, United States of America, and Lagos de Moreno, Jalisco, United States of Mexico to promote mutual understanding, economic cooperation and cultural interchange between the cities and the citizens thereof; and


WHEREAS, the President of the United States has requested the participation of cities in his program to promote mutual understanding between the people of other free countries and of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on International Municipal Cooperation of the American Municipal Association has urged the promotion of the exchange of ideas, techniques and friendship among cities throughout the world;

WHEREAS, preliminary interchanges between the Mayor of said City, The Honorable J. Jesus Delgado Perez, and representatives of the City of Brea revealed a desire to establish an active relationship along the lines proposed by the President of the United States and by the Committee on International Municipal Cooperation of the American Municipal Association;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Brea does hereby adopt the City of Lagos de Moreno, State of Jalisco, United States of Mexico, as its Sister City, and does hereby extend to said City a cordial invitation to engage in a program to promote mutual understanding, cultural exchange and economic cooperation between the Cities of Lagos de Moreno and Brea.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF BREA EXPRESSING INTENT TO ESTABLISH A SISTER
CITY RELATIONSHIP WITH HANNO CITY SAITAMA
PREFECTURE JAPAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Brea does have an active citizen based Sister City Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brea has been approached by the Brea Sister City Committee concerning a sister city relationship in Japan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hanno City Saitama Prefecture Japan has expressed a desire to officially affiliate with the City of Brea in a sister city relationship; and

WHEREAS, the Brea City Council has acted to approve the recommendation of the Brea Sister City Committee to affiliate with Hanno City Saitama Prefecture Japan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Brea does officially go on record as expressing its intent to establish and maintain a sister city relationship with Hanno City Saitama Prefecture Japan and to be supportive of the citizens of the Brea Sister City Committee in the conduct of a meaningful people to people program.

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-72

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BREA EXPRESSING INTENT TO ENTER INTO A SISTER CITY RELATIONSHIP WITH THE CITY OF ANSEONG, GYEONGGI-DO PROVINCE, REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO INVITE THE CITY OF ANSEONG TO ENTER INTO SISTER CITY RELATIONS WITH THE CITY OF BREA

A. RECITALS:

(i) It is to the mutual advantage of the cities of Anseong, Gyeonggi-do Province, Republic of Korea and the City of Brea, California, and the citizens thereof to cultivate economic cooperation and cultural and educational interchange between the cities; and

(ii) President Eisenhower, in 1956, inaugurated the "People-to-People" program to establish greater friendship and understanding between the peoples of the United States and other nations through the medium of direct personal contact; and

(iii) The City of Brea enjoys cultural diversity within its own population, and has significant and growing population of persons of Korean language and heritage; and


(iv) Officials from the Gyeonggi-do Province representing the City of Anseong in the Gyeonggi-do Province has affirmed the desire of the City of Anseong to enter into Sister City relationship with the City of Brea; and

(v) The City Council of the City of Brea recognizes the benefit of developing a friendship and understanding with the City of Anseong, Gyeonggi-do Province, Republic of Korea;

B. RESOLUTION:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Brea hereby expresses its intent to become the Sister City of the City of Anseong, Korea, and authorizes the Mayor to officially extend invitation to the City of Anseong to enter into Sister City relationship with the City of Brea.


